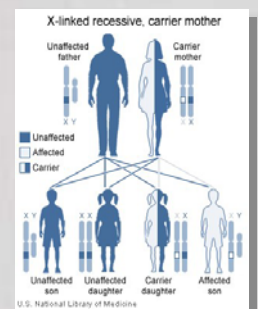

WHAT IS MUSCULAR DYSTROPHY? (MD) (IN BRIEF)

Muscular dystrophy (MD) refers to a group of genetic, hereditary muscle diseases that cause progressive muscle weakness. Muscular dystrophies are characterized by progressive skeletal muscle weakness and defects in muscle proteins. Nine diseases including Duchene, Becker, limb girdle, congenital, facioscapulohumeral, Myotonic, oculopharyngeal, distal, and Emery-Defuses are always classified as muscular dystrophy, but there are more than 100 diseases in total with similarities to muscular dystrophy.



OUR MAJOR PROJECT IAMD CAMPS (Since 1992)

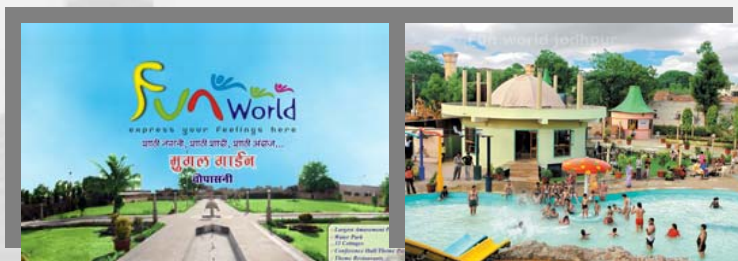
